The CMC designation is a competency mark and originated with the Canadian Institute. The International Council of Management Consulting Institutes (ICMCI) introduced the CMC designation to all members countries in 1991. This ICMCI program plans to promote the designation as *the* symbol of the highest standard of professional advice available.

You will receive a CMC certificate and Practising Certificate. The CMC designation is a competency mark and as such attracts further responsibilities of the recipient. Certified Management Consultants must perform 800 hours consulting per annum and 100 hours of professional development every three years to maintain their Practising Certificate. Your 1996-97 Practising Certificate will be issued upon payment of the CMC upgrade fee.
