

Claus Krummrey started his professional career in the German Merchant Navy, where he received his training and performed his studies to become a Master Mariner Seagoing with a degree as Diplom-Nautiker.

After further studies in the area of Logistics, he entered into a career in the European Space Industry, where he participated in leading functions in the European Space Programs SPACELAB and COLUMBUS, for which his company had been Prime Contractor.
